About the Ottawa Rowing Club

The Ottawa Rowing Club is Canada's oldest rowing club, founded in 1867, the year Canada was created. The club's first patron was Canada's first Prime Minister Sir John A. Macdonald. As well as being Canada's oldest rowing club, the ORC is also one of the countries largest with close to 1000 members. The club offers programs for everyone from competitive junior, senior, adaptive and masters athletes, university and high school rowers, recreational rowers of all skills levels, an adult rowing league, a popular learn-to-row program and a summer youth day camp for young people 12-17 interesting in rowing as beginners or at a more advanced level. The club opens in early April every spring (depending on the weather and the run-off on the Ottawa River) and closes in early November for the winter.



Ottawa Rowing Club Alcohol Policy – Guidelines for Responsible Service of Alcohol

A policy for the responsible use of alcohol during events and functions has been developed to regulate use at the Boathouse banquet facility. If alcohol is to be served at your event, a liquor license is required and can be organized by the Boathouse banquet facility.

Insurance protection

If you are planning to host a banquet or meeting, you will be responsible for providing third party liability insurance in the event of damages, fire and theft. The Ottawa Rowing Club can arrange the liability insurance protection through the City of Ottawa at a minimal cost.

An intimate locale in the tranquility of our beautiful landscape, this picturesque setting accommodates casual and elegant, simple and stunning. Imagine an outdoor ceremony on the terrace surrounded by the living beauty of the *Ottawa River*, *Parliament Hill* and *Gatineau Hills*.

The banquet facility is uniquely designed and located on the upper level of the oldest rowing club in Canada, founded in 1867. The atmosphere of the ORC banquet facility reflects this—surrounding the visitor with trophies and mementoes from the club's long history. The facility has the ambiance of a private club, but the dedicated space (1600 square feet) for organizing full catering services for groups of up to 100 seated or up to 125 standing. Free parking for approximately 60 cars is also available on the grounds. From luxurious to affordable we have the venue for your next business meeting, wedding party or social gathering.



Corporate Team Building and Leadership Experience

The *Ottawa Rowing Club Boathouse* banquet facility, in partnership with the ORC rowing program, can offer you a Corporate Leadership event experience. We combine a half day rowing program with experienced coaches, where participants learn the basics of rowing and water safety and enjoy the teaming and leadership camaraderie of rowing on the scenic Ottawa River. On completion of the rowing experience, we can assist in planning and organizing informal BBQ services, bar or a formal lunch catered by one of our third-party catering services. This event is very popular and requires a minimum of 10 participants with a maximum of 50.

Reservation

A letter or e-mail of confirmation and a deposit is required 7 days after a provisional reservation. Account is payable in full, 14 days upon completion of the event. If you unfortunately need to cancel your booking up to 30 days prior to the event, the Ottawa Rowing Club will retain the confirmation deposit.
